



Albert D. Disposti

Albert Dominic Disposti passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 23rd in Lebanon, NJ at the age of 61.

Albert was born in Italy on September 4th 1949 and immigrated to the United States aboard the ship the Christopher Columbus with his parents in 1958. Albert became a naturalized citizen in 1966 and graduated from Boonton High School in 1968. Albert earned a Bachelor of Arts from Rutgers University in 1975 and earned a Master of Business Administration from Pace University in 1986.

Albert accepted a position with Merrill Lynch and Co. in 1978 working in the World Financial Center in New York City. Albert had a twenty year career with Merrill Lynch and Co. holding several titles including Managing Director and Trading Head of the Money Markets Division and Senior Vice President of Commercial Bonds. After retiring from Merrill Lynch, Albert joined Paine Webber where he instituted and organized the bond sector. For many years Albert also ran a horse breeding and training farm known as Calverley Farm, Inc., that bred and raised several successful thoroughbred racehorses.

In 2001, Albert purchased the Pittstown Inn, spent 2 years on renovations, and in March of 2003 opened The Grill at The Pittstown Inn, a contemporary American restaurant. Albert and The Pittstown Inn received several awards including the Donald B. Jones award for preserving Hunterdon County's heritage as well as the award for Most Promising New Business from the Hunterdon County Chamber of Commerce.

Albert is survived by his wife, Jennifer Miller-Disposti; his daughter from a previous marriage, Courtney Disposti; his two step-children, Nicholas and Katherine Miller; his father, Anthony Disposti; and his sister and brother, Dina Penn and Dominic Disposti. Memorial services will be held at Immaculate Conception Church at 316 Old Allerton Rd in Annandale, NJ at 10:00a.m. on Thursday, March 31st, with a celebration of his life to be followed at The Grill at The Pittstown Inn in Pittstown, NJ.
